2013), the Stellenbosch International Chamber Festival Symphony Orchestra, the South African National Orchestra, the UCT Symphony Orchestra, and the UCT String Ensemble.

- She has also been an ad hoc player for the Cape Philharmonic Orchestra and the Cape Town
 Festival Orchestra. In 2019 she played as concertmaster of the UCT Symphony Orchestra
 under conductor Bernhard Gueller.
- She has a strong love for chamber music and is an active chamber musician. She has performed in various chamber groups and showcases at the Stellenbosch International Chamber Music Festival as well as the UCT College of Music.

- In addition, she was awarded 2nd prize in the 2018 Schock Foundation Prize for Chamber Music and 1st prize for the 2019 Schock Foundation Prize for Chamber Music.
